What is a CPO?

A **Certified Pool Operator** is certified by the National Swimming Pool Foundation (NSPF), a non-profit organization founded in 1964 by the National Swimming Pool Institute to promote education and safety for pool and spa operators.

A **CPO** has taken a detailed, 14-16 hour course and passed a written examination to prove that he or she has a thorough understanding of practical water chemistry as well as pool and spa operation. CPO is valid for 5 years.

The **CPO** designation is the most recognized pool and spa certification in the United States. It is required by many states, counties, and cities throughout the country. **Many Insurance companies offer reduced liability rates to pools that have a CPO on staff.**

- Liability and Risk Management
- Filtration, Circulation and Equipment
- Water Chemistry and Testing
- Spas and Therapy Operations
- Maintenance and Operation
- Care of Seasonal Pools
